UWHS Library provides a sampling of the holdings in the UWHS Library that was compiled over a number of years with contributions from many people. Recognition for the transfer of the UWHS Library to Andover Newton Theological School (ANTS), Andover, MA, was given at the opening of the Unitarian Universalist History and Heritage Society Lecture on May 3, 2012. The collection includes the 1000 volumes in the library and miscellaneous files of several hundred women, as well as copies of UWHS publications. The listing presented here was compiled in 2003; it is not the final inventory that went to ANTS. This material has not been updated since 2012.
